

Louisiana Music Tour Booking Information & Conditions 2013

PAYMENT OF TOUR: Deposit of \$500 per person is due immediately to hold a place on the tour. All checks or money orders should be in U.S. dollars and made payable to Festival Tours International. Please mail your check along with your signed Booking Form and Booking Information & Conditions to Festival Tours International, 15332 Antioch Street #17, Pacific Palisades, CA 90272. **Sorry, credit cards are not accepted.**

Early Bird prices are valid until February 1, 2013. Reservations postmarked after this date will be subject to a \$100 late fee per person.

Balance for the tour is due no later than March 1, 2013. Balances paid after this date will be subject to a \$100 late fee per person.

Prices are based on a minimum of 30 people traveling. Although this rarely happens, the tour price is subject to an increase if numbers fall short of this.

CANCELLATION POLICY: ALL CANCELLATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING BY THE DEADLINE.

There will be a \$500 cancellation fee before February 28, 2013

100% of the tour price will be nonrefundable as of March 1, 2013, although this may be covered by travel and trip cancellation insurance. There can be no partial refund for unused rooms, tickets, etc.

TRAVEL INSURANCE/MEDICAL INSURANCE: We strongly advise you to protect yourself with Travel Insurance, available from any travel agency. **Festival Tours International does not provide this service.** Medical insurance which covers travel to and within Louisiana is required to participate on the tour.

ARRIVAL: For the Full Tour, our first official event will be dinner on Thursday, April 25. We will be departing for the Cajun trip on Monday morning, April 29, at 9 AM from the lobby of the Bourbon Orleans Hotel. If you are coming on the "Cajun Only" portion of the trip, you must meet us by this time or you will be responsible for arranging your own transportation to Eunice and joining the tour there. No refund can be made for any activities that you may have missed.

TOUR INCLUDES: The Full Tour from April 25 - May 2 includes all hotels in New Orleans and the Cajun Country, festival tickets for two (2) days of the first weekend of the New Orleans Jazz & Heritage Festival, plus all transportation, events and most meals in the Cajun Country

SHARING A ROOM: If you are traveling by yourself and wish to share a twin room, we will be happy to try to arrange a suitable roommate for you. This is usually not a problem and can actually add to your enjoyment of the trip. However, if a roommate is not available, you will be required to pay the single supplement of \$850 for the Full Tour, \$100 for the Cajun Only trip, \$170 for the Wednesday, April 24 extension, as applicable.

CAJUN COUNTRY ONLY: Limited space is available for the Cajun Only package. Preference is given to those signing up for the Full Tour, as well as to those joining us for the Welcoming Dinner in New Orleans on Thursday, April 25

MEDICAL CONDITIONS & FOOD RESTRICTIONS: Festival Tours International accepts people in good health who are capable of attending the activities we plan. However, it is helpful for us to be aware of your health conditions or allergies, although we cannot take responsibility for them. Whenever possible, we will ask for vegetarian meals if requested. Please be aware that in certain circumstances, such as the barbecue and crawfish boil on the Cajun trip, there are no alternatives available and you will need to provide alternate food yourself.

RESPONSIBILITY: The Agent, Tour Operators and their representatives give notice that all tickets and coupons are issued by them and all arrangements for transportation and hotel accommodations, etc. are made by them upon the express condition that they shall not be liable for any injury, loss, damage, accident, delay or irregularity that may be occasioned either by reason of defect in any vehicle or through the acts or default of any company or persons engaged in conveying the passenger. Such conveying, etc. is subject to the laws of the country where provided.

The Agent and its representatives accept no responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delays or changes in service which may be caused by illness, weather, strikes, declared or undeclared war, quarantine or other causes. Such losses or expenses must be borne by the passenger. The right is reserved to amend or revise the routes or schedules listed in the itineraries, or to cancel any portion or all of the tour.

We will be visiting private homes, traveling on privately owned boats and by other means of transportation. We may come into contact with local wildlife, including alligators.
